MAP STATEMENTS

Felling of trees in Units 4,5,6 shall not occur between the hours of 8am and 4:30pm Monday through Friday, or between 9am and 3pm on Saturday and Sunday without prior written authorization from the Forest Service(CT6.315#)

Purchaser shall provide a written notice at least 2 weeks prior to felling trees on each payment unit (CT6.315#)

Clean equipment prior to moving equipment from Units 1 and 2 (CT6.42#)

Felling of trees within Unit 6 cannot occur until all the terms and provisions of the Work Zone Plan approved by the Washington Department of Transportation are met (CT6.315#)

Dedicated ground based skid trails shall be no closer than 110 feet apart center to center (except where converging) and will not exceed 12 feet in width (CT6.42#)

Log lengths shall not exceed 40 feet plus trim and may be reduced if damage occurs to the residual stand. Tree crowns shall remain attached to the last log during skidding and processed at the landing (CT6.42#)

The locations of all skid trails and landings will be approved by the Forest Service prior to felling operations (CT6.42#)

All logging generated slash will be piled and covered in the area indicated on this map (C6.74#)

All landings and skid trails are subject to scarification and seeding/mulching (CT6.6#)
