Happy Camp Complex Update Closure Area Reduced

Yreka, CA - With the arrival of cooler temperatures, and higher relative humidity, fire activity on the Happy Camp Complex is low. Smoke production from the Hooligan Lake and Toms Valley Creek areas decreased yesterday. Smoke may still be observed from the Elk Creek drainage and Norcross trail head. Rain fell over the fire area yesterday and the weather outlook is for continued showers for the remainder of the week and into early next week. Repair work continues in all areas of the fire.

Happy Camp Complex Closure Area

A new Forest Closure Order (14-05-762) went in affect today, shrinking the closure area significantly and opening areas for firewood cutters and deer hunters and other visitors to National Forest lands.
