



**ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
SETTING FORTH RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS
CLOSING AN AREA TO ENTRY ON THE HURON-MANISTEE NATIONAL FOREST**

**NATIONAL FOREST LANDS
HURON SHORES RANGER DISTRICT**

Under the authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, as amended (16 USC 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (CFR 261.50(a) and (b)), the following acts and omissions are prohibited within, in and adjacent to National Forest Lands located within: The Huron Shores Ranger District, Iosco and Alcona Counties, Michigan.

This order includes all areas off the County and Forest Service open roads with said area being more particularly described and designated on the map set forth in Exhibit A, with said exhibit being attached hereto and made a part of this Closure Order.

Prohibition: To go into, enter, use or be upon any land within the areas described and depicted on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.53 (e)

AS A RESULT OF EXISTING, POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS CAUSED BY USE OF THE AREA AS A BOMBING AND GUNNERY RANGE, THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261.

THIS PROHIBITION WILL BE IN EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE AREA IS DEEMED SAFE FOR PUBLIC ENTRY.

This Order includes all of the National Forest System Lands within the following legal descriptions:

This order will remain in effect for until such time the area has been made safe for public entry.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons will be exempt from the order:

1. Persons with a valid permit in their possession signed by the District Ranger or Forest Supervisor specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1); and,
2. Any Federal, State, or Local officers, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4).
3. Individuals identified as exempt in other agreements or MOU (Memorandum of Understanding).

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571




