

Forest Plan Revision Public Involvement Milestones and Timeline

NEPA for Forest Plan Revisions Begins

- August 29, 2014: "Notice of Intent" published in the Federal Register-begins 30-day public scoping process
- September 15-18, 2014: Tribal Forums and Public Workshops: scoping
- September 29, 2014: Scoping period ends
- November 2014: Tribal Forums and Public Workshops: Preliminary Alternatives
- April 2015: "Notice of Availability of DEIS" published-begins 90-day public comment period
- May 2015: Tribal Forums and Public Workshops: Draft EIS and Draft Forest Plans
- March 2016: "Notice of Availability of FEIS" published. Begin 60-day objection filing period
- September 2016: "Notice of Plan Approval" published
- October 2016: Implement Forest Plans 30-days after Notice of Plan Approval

Pre-NEPA Forest Plan Revision Milestones

- Public feedback accepted through June 30, 2014
- June 16-20, 2014: Tribal Forums and Public Workshops: Updated Need to Change, Draft Desired Conditions, Preliminary Wilderness Inventory, and other topics
- April 30, 2014: Sierra Cascades Dialog #13
- February 27, 2014: Sierra Cascades Dialog #12
- January 13 - 30, 2014: Tribal Forums and Public Workshops: Preliminary Need to Change
- December 26, 2013: "Notice to Initiate" published in Federal Register and local newspapers
- December 24, 2013: Final Forest Assessments, Bio-Regional Assessment, Preliminary Need to Change
