

PRESOLICITATION

Cave Thin Stewardship Project

Road 8620000

The project site is located approximately 7 miles west of Trout Lake, Washington on the Mount Adams Ranger District of the Gifford Pinchot National Forest. Construction will take place at Cave Creek on forest road 8620 approximately mile post 0.6.

The project mainly consists of removal and disposal of an 72-inch x 60-inch arch x 40-ft length corrugated metal pipe and furnishing and installation of an approximately 5-ft x 40-ft x 30-ft length three sided concrete bottomless culvert with wingwalls and concrete footing foundation. The project also consists of installation and furnishing an approximately 36-inch x 40-ft corrugated metal overflow culvert pipe located approximately 60 feet from the concrete culvert. Other items include excavation, embankment, waste haul, furnishing and placing crushed aggregate and riprap, streambed reconstruction including placement of woody debris and/or rock materials, traffic control, and temporary and permanent erosion control.

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools, transportation and supplies, and perform all work required according to the drawings and specifications of the contract. The Contractor shall assume all risk, loss, damage, or expense arising out of prosecution of the work, except as otherwise provided in the contract.
