The Forest is located within one hour's drive of approximately two million people and is the closest Forest Service office to the Utah State Capitol and the headquarters of many state and federal agencies and organizations important to the Forest Service. This position takes an active role in management of a large, complex National Forest adjacent to a large metropolitan area. We are looking for an individual with diverse skills to assist the Forest leadership in this complex and sensitive political atmosphere.

The Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest is one of the most visited Forests in the nation and the management of balancing demand of the proximity of hundreds of thousands of outdoor enthusiasts is a constant theme. We are looking for someone who can seek creative and efficient ways to implement our programs and build partnership capacity. Together with the Forest Supervisor, this position supervises seven District Rangers, five Staff Officers, one Safety Officer and one Program Specialist.
