SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS FOR LAGUNA RECREATION SITE

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the area and roads as described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, "Restricted Area", all within the Mesa Ranger District, Tonto National Forest, Maricopa County, Arizona:

1. Entering or using the Laguna Recreation Site at Canyon Lake or any portion thereof as described below. 36 CFR 261.58b

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any persons, volunteers, contractors or employees from the Arizona Game and Fish Department or Forest Service while engaged in official duties.

**AREA DESCRIBED**

The restricted area includes all National Forest System lands and roads within the boundary of the Laguna Recreation Site at Canyon Lake, Tonto National Forest, as depicted in Exhibit A of this order and as described below.

From the junction of Highway 88 and National Forest System Road (NFSR) 150 proceeding southeast along the northern edge of the pavement on Highway 88 to a point immediately south of the eastern-most edge of the parking lot, proceed north along the eastern edge of the pavement on NFSR 150 to the waterline, westerly along the waterline around the courtesy dock (inclusive). Continuing from the courtesy dock westerly along the waterline, to the western edge of the pavement, then south along the western edge of the pavement on NFSR 150 back to the junction of Highway 88 and NFSR 150. SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS FOR LAGUNA RECREATION SITE

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this order is the protection of National Forest visitors, employees, film crew and volunteers, the prevention of user conflicts, the conservation of natural resources, and the protection of property belonging to the United States.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. The prohibition contained in this order becomes effective beginning 5:00 am Wednesday, November 19, 2014 and will remain in effect until 8:00 pm Thursday, November 20, 2014, unless terminated sooner.
2. This restriction is in addition to the general prohibitions found at 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.
3. Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581].
