APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Application deadlines are set in USA Jobs and can't be changed by the local districts. You can find them by checking the Forest Service and BLM employment websites listed on the reverse of this pamphlet or by checking with zone hiring contacts.



Applications are usually required within a 1 week period, by 11:59 **EASTERN time**— make sure you check & account for the time zone differences when submitting your application!!

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Firefighters have to love to work and live outdoors. Working on wildfires requires staying at a camp that could be very remote, sleeping in tents and eating MREs (Meals Ready to Eat) to staying in a large fire camp with catered meals and showers. Fire-fighters are ready to respond to a fire 24 hours a day. Many times fire-fighters are dispatched to a fire from the field and may be required to stay up to 14 days on an incident anywhere in the US. The work varies from digging line with hand tools, cutting line with chainsaws, providing support with water from aircraft, engines, pumps or portable tanks to backfiring with fusees or drip torches.

When there are few or no wildfires, firefighters often work to help enhance fuels, facilities, wildlife, range & recreation projects.

Firefighters hike in steep terrain, carry heavy loads, and do demanding physical work for long hours. Firefighters work in the extremes - hot, cold, rain, snow and smoky conditions.

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. Citizenship
- Valid Driver's License
- At least 18 years old (when reporting to work)
- Negative Drug Testing
- Pass Work Capacity Test (pack test)
- Complete Basic Fire School - once hired

PHYSICAL TRAINING

Physical training and conditioning is a must prior to starting a job as a wildland firefighter. At least one hour each workday is devoted to physical training. Every year we strive to provide our employees with the best on the job training.

All employees must take and pass a Work Capacity Test (WCT) at the Arduous level as a condition of employment.

This "Pack Test" consists of:

- * 3 mile hike carrying a
- * 45 pound pack completed in
- * 45 minutes or less

Each crew has their own fitness goals and ways of maintaining fitness and personal training.

This announcement constitutes the required 30 days advance notice for testing requirements
