

**FOREST ORDER
USDA FOREST SERVICE
RIO GRANDE NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R) 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on National Forest System Road (NFSR) 118 Trujillo Meadows Road (from the intersection of CO HWY 17 to the end of FSR 118 which ends at Trujillo Meadows Reservoir), on the Conejos Peak Ranger District of the Rio Grande National Forest, Conejos County, State of Colorado, (the "Restricted Road"). The Restricted Road is depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety and to protect the National Forest System Road and associated resources.

PROHIBITIONS:

- Using any vehicle or motorized vehicle. 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.54(a)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3) Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation in the area in the performance of work specifically authorized by the Forest Service.

This Order will be effective upon signing and shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until *December 31, 2014*, at 11:59 PM, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these provisions is punishable as a class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for and individual or \$10,000.00 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. §551, and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571.
