**Cottage Grove Ranger District**

Order No. 06-15-01-14-318

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(a), and to provide for equal camping opportunities by any person or group and for the protection of natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the boundaries of the Cottage Grove Ranger District as described below and shown in attached maps Exhibit A and Exhibit B. The Order is effective beginning December 1, 2014 and ending on December 31, 2016, unless rescinded sooner.

**CAMPING by any person or group, within the boundaries described below and identified in Exhibit A and Exhibit B maps is restricted to a combined total of 14 days or less during any 45 day period.** [36 CFR 261.58(a)]

Brice Creek corridor's affected stay limit includes portions along County Road 2470 (Brice Creek/Champion Creek), Forest Service Roads 2200 (Brice Creek) and 2213 (Grass Creek). Closure includes all developed and dispersed campgrounds including fee and non-fee sites. Closure is valid within 300' of both sides of all roads as defined by attached maps.

Sharps Creek corridor's affected stay limit includes portions along County Road 2460 (Sharps Creek/Hardscrabble), Forest Service Roads 2300 (Martin Creek), & 2300-721 (Quartz Creek). Closure includes all developed and dispersed campgrounds including fee and non-fee sites. Closure is valid within 300' of both sides of all roads as defined by attached maps.

**Camping means the temporary use of National Forest System lands for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently-fixed structure.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local Officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.




