**Subject:** Forest Order No. 14-14-07 – McKenzie Butte and Pilgrim Creek Road Closures

I am implementing a Forest Order to close the roads described below on the McCloud Ranger District on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b). The order prohibits being on Pilgrim Creek Road (Forest Road No. 42N13), from milepost 2.5 then northeast to its intersection with Forest Road No. 40N34Y and being on McKenzie Butte Road (Forest Road No. 41N31), from milepost 8.9 then northeast to mile post 9.1.

This Order is effective from December 1, 2014 through November 30, 2015 and is being implemented as a result of a mudslide that occurred at the Konwakiton glacier on Mt Shasta September 20, 2014. The McKenzie Butte road has been severely damaged and buried by the debris and water which both are continuing to flow over the road. The Pilgrim Creek road has been closed due to continuing debris and water flowing over the road. It is expected that slide material will continue to move down the mountain and impact these roads for the foreseeable future. The closed roads described in this order are hazardous to the public and should not be used.

I have concluded that this decision may be categorically excluded from documentation in an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) or Environmental Assessment (EA) under the National Environmental Policy Act. This action falls within the category identified in 36 CFR 220.6(d)(1) – prohibitions to provide short-term resource protection or to protect public health and safety – and does not require documentation in a decision memo, decision notice, or record of decision. I have determined that there are no extraordinary circumstances associated with this temporary closure. Implementation of the decision may begin immediately.

ROAD CLOSURE  
USDA Forest Service  
**Shasta-Trinity National Forest**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the McCloud Ranger District of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from December 1, 2014 through November 30, 2015.

Being on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on the attached map.

- a. Pilgrim Creek Road (Forest Road No. 42N13), from milepost 2.5 then northeast to its intersection with Forest Road No. 40N34Y.
- b. McKenzie Butte Road (Forest Road No. 41N31), from milepost 8.9 then northeast to mile post 9.1.

36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.  
16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
