Special Road Restrictions, Road Closure Order
 For National Forest System Road (NFSR) 300 (Four Mile Road), NFSR 302 (Baylor Park Bypass Road) and NFSR 800 (West Divide Creek Road)
 During Commercial Operations Associated With the Haystack Timber Sale

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the described National Forest System Roads (NFSR) located within the Sopris Ranger District, White River National Forest, Garfield County, Colorado and Pitkin County, Colorado (the "Restricted Roads"). The Restricted Roads are also depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. Refer to the White River National Forest Winter Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) for additional winter use information and restrictions in the area.

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety during commercial logging operations (including but not limited to project access, log haul, tree cutting, decking and loading trucks on roads, snowplowing and other road maintenance activities) natural gas operations (including but not limited to project access, use of a snow cat, snowplowing and other road maintenance activities) associated with routine winter monitoring of gas wells in the vicinity.

The Restricted Roads are further defined as follows:

- A. National Forest System Road 300 - From approximately 3.4 miles (MP 3.4 – NFSR 300) from the intersection with Garfield County Road 117 (MP 0.0 – NFSR 300) to the intersection with Texas City Road (NFSR 300.3R) (MP 5.1 – NFSR 300) located in Four Mile Park (SE¼ of Section 1, T8S, R90W).
- B. National Forest System Road 300 - From the Texas City Road (NFSR 300.3R) (SE¼ of Section 1, T8S, R90W) or approx. 5.1 miles from the intersection with Garfield County Road 117 (MP 0.0 – NFSR 300) to the intersection with NFSR 800 (SE¼ of Section 34, T8S, R90W) (MP 11.1 – NFSR 300)
- C. National Forest System Road 800 - From the intersection of NFSR 300 (SE¼ of Section 34, T8S, R90W) (MP 11.1 – NFSR 300) to the intersection with NFSR 302 bypass (NE¼ of Section 4, T9S, R90W)
- D. NFSR 302 bypass to road closure gate accessing Haystack Timber Sale (NE¼ of Section 4, T9S, R90W)

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being on the Restricted Roads (36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)) identified as A, B, C, D above with an over snow vehicle at any time
2. Being on the Restricted Roads (36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)) identified as B, C, D at any time during the week (Monday through Friday*) with any motorized or mechanized (bicycles) vehicles; or non-motorized types of access including but not limited to; hiking, horseback, snowshoeing, skiing, dogsledding etc.
 - * "Week" shall be defined as dawn Monday through dusk Friday. However, the week beginning Monday, 11/24/14 shall be defined as Monday, 11/24/14 dawn through Wednesday, 11/26/2014 dusk.


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service contract or permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.


This Order shall be in effect beginning upon the date of the signing of this order and continue until rescinded or until December 25, 2014, or as road conditions allow, whichever event occurs last.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571)


