

# STRATEGIC RESPONSE TO CRISIS

APRIL 9—APRIL 10, 2015

The Danny Rhynes Interagency Training Center will be hosting a Strategic Response to Crisis training, April 9-10, 2015 in San Bernardino, California. This course will present essential information for the assessment of both crisis situations and the effects of critical incidents on people involved in those situations. Participants will learn to create an effective plan of action to assist those in crisis and participate in exercises designed to sharpen assessment and crisis planning skills. Strategic planning and tactical decision making will be emphasized and rationales for choosing one set of crisis intervention processes over another.

Program highlights: Strategic planning as it applies to crisis intervention, National Incident Management System and crisis intervention, elements of effective planning, steps in developing the plan, planning process in assessing target populations, determining the type, timing and resources necessary, assisting large numbers of people involved in a crisis, the most important crisis intervention tactics, managing a complicated or large scale crisis event.
