

## Interested in a summer job with the Forest Service?

Apply at [www.usajobs.gov](http://www.usajobs.gov) beginning Dec. 2!

**Vacancies can occur any time after Dec. 2, and will remain open for a very short time; be sure to check the announcement for the closure date.**

Here's how:

- **Decide which jobs you are interested in:**
  - **Fire, information assistant, timber, recreation, wilderness, fuels, engineering equipment operator, physical science tech, automotive equipment dispatcher, animal packer, biological science tech, range tech, trails tech and forestry technicians and forestry aids for fire.**
- **Register on [usajobs.gov](http://usajobs.gov), if you do not already have an account**
- **Search [www.usajobs.gov](http://www.usajobs.gov) for vacancies on the National Forest of your choice.**
- **On Dec. 2, you can begin applying for summer positions. Remember to check the vacancy closure date because you will no longer be able to apply for that position once it closes.**
- **Do not go back into the vacancy announcement after the closing date. This has caused applications to be excluded from the applicant pool.**
- **Once your resume has been entered in your account and saved, you can use it for multiple applications.**
