## Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest Salt Lake & Heber-Kamas Ranger Districts

***The Salt Lake & Heber-Kamas Ranger Districts are seeking a Natural Resources Specialist (Recreation), GS-0401-7/9 to join our teams! There are two positions, one in Salt Lake City and one in Heber City, Utah, focusing on Trails, Wilderness, Travel Management and Dispersed Recreation programs.***

**We are looking for experienced recreation professionals that are enthusiastic and highly motivated, that like fast-paced and challenging work environments, and enjoy working with partnerships and diverse communities in a high profile settings!**

**Uinta-Wasatch Cache National Forest:** Located in northern Utah and southwestern Wyoming, the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache (UWC) National Forest encompasses 2.3 million acres of spectacular scenery, unlimited recreation opportunities, nine wilderness areas, seven ranger districts, and borders both rural and urban communities. There are many reasons to select the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest as your employer of choice! There are opportunities to satisfy your hunger for recreation activities including skiing, snowboarding, snowmobiling, hiking, mountain biking, camping, picnicking, fishing, boating, swimming, and horseback riding. Enjoy cultural events? The majority of the Forest is within close driving distance to theater, arts, cinema, and year-round festivals. You can work in the backcountry during the day and enjoy fine dining in the evening! The Forest is a popular destination for 9 million visitors each year.

**Salt Lake Ranger District:** The district is an "urban" forest where more than a million people reside in the adjacent Salt Lake, Davis and Tooele Counties. The annual snowpack is both an important source of water for local communities and a draw for skiers and snowboarders enjoying the "Greatest Snow on Earth." The District's proximity, scenic beauty, and year-round recreation opportunities means that it is a beloved and busy place. The district office is located in the City of Cottonwood Heights, a suburb of the Salt Lake City Metropolitan Area and adjacent to 3 Wilderness areas, spectacular recreation opportunities, and 4 ski areas. There is a wide array of housing types for rent or purchase within easy commuting distance to the office. An extensive public transportation system serves the Salt Lake Valley.

**Heber-Kamas Ranger District:** Heber City, Utah is located in Wasatch County (Heber Valley) approximately 30 miles northeast of Provo and 45 miles southeast of the Salt Lake City area. Wasatch County has an estimated population of 17,500. Most of the residents reside in Heber Valley's four cities: Heber City, Charleston, Midway, and Wallsburg. Heber City serves as the county seat with a population of approximately 8,600. Heber Valley offers a year-round recreation paradise. A wide range of activities are available for the outdoor enthusiast, including fishing, hunting, camping, back-packing, horseback riding, mountain biking, golfing, sailing, boating, mountain climbing, snowmobiling, skiing, and snowboarding. Scenic drives can be found in any direction. This is also the gateway to many wilderness areas, including Lone Peak, Timpanogos, Nebo, and the High Uintas. Many other recreation areas are a day's drive or less from Heber Valley, since there are more National Parks and Monuments in Utah than in any other State.

**Duties of the Salt Lake Ranger District position include:**

- Recruitment, hiring and supervision of 2 permanent employees, a large temporary workforce, and volunteers.
- Planning/NEPA, implementation, and monitoring of Wilderness, Trails, Dispersed Recreation, Travel Management and Winter Recreation projects.
- Writing of, execution and monitoring of grants and agreements related to Wilderness, Trails, Dispersed Recreation, Travel Management and Winter Recreation programs.
- Utilizes databases such as WorkPlan, NRM/Iweb (INFRA Trails, INFRA WILD, SUDS, etc.), eTracker, Paycheck 8, etc.
- Budget oversight/tracking, management, operations & maintenance of 4 Wilderness Areas, the district's Trails, Dispersed Recreation, Travel Management (includes Roads & Signs program and coordination with Forest Road Crew), and Winter Recreation (winter camping and facility maintenance) programs.
- Assist in the management of the military weapons program for avalanche control.

**Duties of the Heber-Kamas Ranger District position include:**

- Recruitment, hiring and supervision of 3 permanent seasonal employees, a large temporary workforce, and volunteers.
- Planning/NEPA, implementation, and monitoring of travel management, trails, wilderness, dispersed recreation, and winter recreation projects.
- Writing, executing, and monitoring of grants and agreements related to travel management, trails, wilderness, dispersed recreation and winter recreation programs.
- Utilizes databases such as WorkPlan, NRM/Iweb (INFRA Trails, INFRA WILD, SUDS, etc.), eTracker, Paycheck 8.
- Budget oversight/tracking, management, operations & maintenance of travel management, trails wilderness, and dispersed recreation programs.
- Assist with overall management of district's Winter Recreation program. Includes budget oversight/tracking, management, operations, maintenance, grooming winter trail using a snowmachine, and providing trail updates.
