2015 Early Alert: Seasonal River Ranger Jobs

The Salmon-Challis National Forest Recreation Program is currently looking to fill positions to be part of a River Patrol crew. Employment will last from approximately late May through October. All of the filled positions will be stationed at one of the Ranger Districts on the Salmon-Challis National Forest and all of the work schedules will be 40 hours/week with typical tour being 8 days and 6 days off. This notification is being circulated to inform prospective applicants of this opportunity.

Housing: Government Quarters may or may not be available for this position. Employees seeking rental can expect a range from \$500 - \$800/month.

Position Duties

- Patrol Wild and Scenic River within Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness rowing a 14' raft and/or kayak in class III & IV whitewater.
- Patrol within the wilderness to ensure that visitors understand and abide by the rules and regulations. Clean up around river banks, campsites, and trailsides as necessary.
- Act as an interpreter to the public, becoming familiar with the trails, trees, flowers, rocks, wildlife and wilderness practices.
- Assist in wilderness monitoring and restoration projects.
