UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOREST SERVICE FISHLAKE NATIONAL FOREST

Occupancy and Use

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) the following acts are prohibited within the Fishlake National Forest until further notice.

- Occupying the same campground unit for a period longer than 14 consecutive days within any developed campground; campers who vacate a campground unit after the maximum limit of days may not return to the same campground for at least 10 days. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
- 2. Occupying any general undeveloped area for more than 16 days within the calendar year. Subsequent comping locations must be at least 5 road miles from any previous location; campers may not return to the same campsite within the calendar year. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
- 3. Camping in any other area designated No Camping, 36 CFR 261.58(e).
- 4. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.58(g).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

All National Forest System Lands within the Fishlake National Forest, excluding the Fish Lake/Johnson Recreation Area. Refer to the Special Order specific for the Fish Lake/Johnson Recreation Area.

DEFINITION:

Camping is defined as the erecting of a tent or shelter of natural or synthetic material, parking of a motor vehicle, motor home, RV or trailer, and/or preparing a sleeping bag or other bedding material for the apparent purpose of overnight occupancy of a site.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- 1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
- 2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
- 3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
- 4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above-described area.
