

**OFF-ROAD VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST
FLAGSTAFF RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the restricted area as described below and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, in the Coconino National Forest, Flagstaff Ranger District in Coconino County.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1) Possess or use any type of motorized vehicle on or off forest developed roads on National Forest System lands as described in Exhibit A, **36 CFR 261.54(a)**.
- 2) Possess or use any type of motorized vehicle off Forest System, **36 CFR 261.56**

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The restricted area, known as Woody Ridge, can be described as the area occurring south of Woody Mountain bounded on the west by Forest Road 231, 231L, and 535D, on the east by Forest Road 533 and State Highway 89A, south along Woody Ridge to Fry Canyon. The restricted area only applies to National Forest System lands. See attached Exhibit A.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order becomes effective at 08:00 AM, January 12, 2015, and will remain in force until January 31, 2017 or until rescinded.





Exhibit A

The closure boundary adheres to main roads in the vicinity of the closure area. The closure does not affect any private, state, county, or other Non-National Forest System lands within the closure boundary.
