



CEMENT MOUNTAIN TRAIL #553 →
6.8 MILES ONE WAY

DIFFICULTY: Moderate

SEASON OF USE: Summer through fall.

ELEVATION GAIN: Trailhead is at 10,600', the saddle is at 11,600', and the intersection with Deadman Gulch Trail #420 is at 10,440'.

USGS MAP: Cement Mountain.

ACCESS #1: From Gunnison, travel north on Highway 135 for approximately 16 miles to Jacks Cabin Cutoff Road #813. Turn right onto Jacks Cabin Cutoff and travel to the summit where FSR #810 heads north. Continue on #810 for approximately 1.25 miles to the intersection with FSR #813.A2. Follow this road for approximately 2.5 miles to its end. This is where the Cement Mountain Trail #553 begins.

ACCESS #2: Hike in on the Deadman Gulch Trail or Rosebud Gulch Trail to the intersection.

ATTRACTIONS: The trail ascends gradually as it follows Roaring Judy Creek. After wandering through the saddle between Cement Mountain and East Cement Mountain, the trail descends quickly for $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and then traverses until the intersection with the Rosebud Trail #423. Another 3.6 miles to the north, northwest takes you to the intersection with the Deadman Gulch Trail.

CONSIDERATIONS: Please do not ride motorcycles or mountain bikes on this trail in wet conditions. Always be prepared for adverse weather including rain, hail, thundershowers and lightning. Be sure to wear sunscreen and bring plenty of drinking water. Do not drink from mountain streams and lakes without treating the water first. Be sure someone knows where you are going and when you plan to return.
