OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a), and for the health and safety of the public, and for the protection of resources, the following act is prohibited on all National Forest System land within the entire George Washington and Jefferson National Forests which is not specifically identified and covered by an Order prohibiting any and all possession of alcoholic beverages.


1. Possessing any alcoholic beverage in violation of any applicable State Law which restricts the possession and use of alcoholic beverages. 36 CFR 261.58(bb)

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

This order will expire five (5) years after the date of execution.
