Location
Take 89 north (turn on 2nd St.) from McKee and go 3 miles. Turn right on Macedonia Road for 1/2 mile. Turn left on Turkey Foot Road for 1 mile. The road turns to gravel, Forest Road #4. Stay on this for 1.9 miles. Turn left onto Forest Road 345 and follow signs to the campground.

Turkey Foot Campground, located on London District, is nestled along the banks of War Fork Creek in Jackson County. The creek is stocked with trout throughout the year, and fishing from the bank is popular. A playfield with a horseshoe pit is located in the picnic area alongside the creek. All of the campsites are wooded, and some hillside sites will have steps leading up to them. Each site is equipped with picnic table, fire ring, tent pad, and lantern pole. There is no water, electric or dump station available in the campground. All of the sites are within easy walking distance of the creek. Trails nearby include Sheltoewe Trace National Recreation Trail #100 and Turkey Foot Loop Trail System #303.

- The gravel road into the campground is quite steep and may be unsuitable for campers towing large trailers, or passenger cars with very low clearance.
- Use caution at the low water ford across the creek at the campground entrance. Do not cross if flooded.
- Campfires are permitted in fire rings only. Make sure fires are completely out before retiring at night or when leaving your campsite.
- Packing out all your trash will reduce food odors that attract bears.

FOOD STORAGE REQUIRED. Visitors in developed sites must store food, garbage and other odorous items that may attract bears in a bear-resistant container, inside their vehicle, or in an enclosed hard-body trailer. Backcountry campers must suspend food, garbage and odorous items at least 10 feet off the ground and four feet away from any tree or pole. All food leftovers and trash must be packed out.



