**Directions**  
From I-75, at London Exit 38, turn west on KY 192, go 14.2 miles, then turn south (left) on KY 1193, go 3 miles.



**Parking**  
Parking is available at the Holly Bay Campground parking area, which is closed in the winter.



**Open Dates**  
Trail is open all year.



**Fees**  
No fee for trail use.



**Restrooms**  
Flush toilets at marina.



**Water**  
Drinking water at marina.



**Accessibility**  
This trail does not meet accessibility standards for persons with disabilities.



Trails closed to motorized vehicles.



Consumption of alcohol and open containers of alcohol are prohibited.



No swimming or fishing at boat ramps.



No horses in developed recreation areas.

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Holly Bay Trail #481 is located near Holly Bay Campground on Laurel River Lake. Laurel River Lake is located on London Ranger District and features 5,600 acres of clear, deep water and nearly 200 miles of tree-lined shore.


Holly Bay Campground, a US Fee Area, is located on the west side of Laurel River Lake, about two miles north of Laurel River Dam. Holly Bay Marina is a full-service marina offering rental boats, camping and fishing supplies, fishing licenses, and maps of the lake.

**Holly Bay Trail #481.** Paralleling KY 1193, this trail connects Forest Road 132 with the Sheltoewe Trace at Forest Road 611B. It intersects the Holly Bay Campground entrance road as well as Forest Roads 616, 611A. Starting at the Holly Bay Campground entrance road, it can be combined with the Sheltoewe Trace (Trail #100) and Trail #482 to make a loop of about three miles.

## FOOD STORAGE REQUIRED

Visitors in developed sites must store food, garbage and other odorous items that may attract bears in a bear-resistant container, inside their vehicle, or in an enclosed hard-body trailer. Backcountry campers must hang food, garbage and odorous items at least 10 feet off the ground and 4 feet away from any tree or pole.
