**Directions**  
**From London** at I-75, exit 41, travel west on KY 80 for 13 miles. Turn left onto Sandy Gap Road for 2.5 miles. Turn left onto KY 1675 for 3.1 miles. Turn left into the Goodwater trailhead parking area.  
**From Somerset**, take KY 80 east 9.5 miles. Turn right onto KY 1675 for 3.1 miles. Turn left into the Goodwater trailhead parking area.



**Open Dates**  
Trail open all year.



**Trail Fees**  
None.



**Parking**  
At the trailhead parking area.



**Restrictions:**  
Vehicles must stay on designated trail. No cross-country travel allowed. A helmet is required.



Unlicensed vehicles are prohibited on public roads and highways.



Consumption of alcohol and open containers of alcohol are prohibited.

Goodwater OHV Route is suitable for all-terrain vehicles less than 50" in width. This loop trail, located on London Ranger District, is for intermediate drivers experienced in sharp turns, hills, and uneven terrain. Stay on marked trail. No cross country travel permitted.

Motor Vehicle Use Maps (MVUM) display National Forest System roads and trails that are designated as open to motorized travel by passenger vehicles or off-highway vehicles. <http://www.fs.usda.gov/main/dbnf/maps-pubs>. These maps illustrate where designated trails are located. All other areas of the forest are closed to OHV use.

Vehicles **50 inches or less** in width may ride all designated OHV trails identified on the motor vehicle use maps. Vehicles greater than 50 inches wide may use Forest Service roads which are identified on the motor vehicle use map as open to the public. These vehicles must be licensed for road use according to state laws. All cross country motorized travel and use of trails not identified on the motor vehicle use map are prohibited.



### FOOD STORAGE REQUIRED.

Visitors in developed sites must store food, garbage and other odorous items that may attract bears in a bear-resistant container, inside their vehicle, or in an enclosed hard-body trailer. All food leftovers and trash must be properly disposed of in a bear-resistant trash can or other container where provided by the Forest Service.




