SIERRA PRIETA #366

GENERAL INFORMATION: Good views of W Yavapai Co throughout the trail. Also views of Spruce Mt. and Williams Peak on the northeast. The trail ends where it converges on 2 dirt roads.

CAUTION: This trail is open to hikers, horseback riders, mountain bicyclists and motorcycles. Please be considerate of others—slow down and know when to yield the trail.

ACCESS AND TRAILHEAD LOCATION: From Downtown Prescott take Gurley St. west toward Thumb Butte (about 3.2 miles). You are now on the Thumb Butte Rd. (CO 65). Go left on FR 373 where the road divides to Deering Park (right) and Sierra Prieta overlook (left). Go for about 3.5 miles and park at Sierra Prieta overlook turnout. The trail starts across the road, up a steep bank.

TRAVEL TIME: 30 minutes from downtown Prescott

ROAD CONDITIONS: This road suitable for passenger cars and horse trailers.

HIKING TIME: 1 hour, round trip **LENGTH:** 1.8 miles **DIFFICULTY:** Moderate **USE:** Moderate

NOTES: Parking at Sierra Prieta overlook may be shared with visitors enjoying the spectacular view of west Yavapai Co. Be careful when parking at the Sierra Prieta overlook as there is a steep drop-off to the west.

RECOMMENDED SEASONS OF USE: Spring, summer, fall, winter
