

Order No. 03-15-101
Eldorado National Forest
King Fire Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Georgetown, Placerville and Pacific Ranger Districts of the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from February 2, 2015 to September 30, 2015.

1. Going into or being upon any National Forest System lands within the King Fire Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map, except for those developed sites listed below. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
 - a. Stumpy Meadows Boat Ramp & Picnic Area
 - b. Ponderosa Cove Group Campground

2. Being on any National Forest System road within the King Fire Closure Area as shown on the attached map, except those listed below. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
 - a. Forest Road No. 11N55 (Peavine Ridge Road)
 - b. Forest Road No. 12N30 (Bryant Springs Road)
 - c. Forest Road No. 12N52 (Wolf Creek Road)
 - d. Forest Road No. 12N78 (Union Valley Road)
 - e. Forest Road No. 12N22 (Headache)
 - f. Forest Road No. 13N28 (South Creek Road)
 - g. Forest Road No. 13N24 (Dry Lakes)
 - h. Forest Road No. 17N12 (Soda Springs-Riverton Road)
 - i. Forest Road No. 14N07 (Lawyer Cow Camp Road)
 - j. Forest Road No. 14N27 (Bunker Meadow Road)
 - k. Forest Road No. 12N64 (Sand Mountain Blvd)

3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the King Fire Closure except Forest Trail No. 14E02, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.




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Exhibit A

The King Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Federal Highway 50 and Ice House Road (ELD-147) then continues north along Ice House Road to its intersection with Forest Road No. 11N55 (Peavine Ridge Road), then continues west along Forest Road No. 11N55 (Peavine Ridge Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 12N30 (Bryant Springs Road), then continues north and northeast along Forest Road No. 12N30 (Bryant Springs Road) to its terminus at Forest Road No. 12N52 (Wolf Creek), then continues east along Forest Road No. 12N52 to its terminus at Forest Road No. 12N78 (Union Valley), then continues north and east along Forest Road No. 12N78 (Union Valley) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 12N22, then continues north along Forest Road No. 12N22 (Headache) to its terminus at Ice House Road (ELD-147), then continues north along Ice House Road (ELD-147) to its intersection with South Ice Road (ELD-147F), then continues west along South Ice Road (ELD-147F) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 13N28 (South Creek Road), then continues northwest and northeast along Forest Road No. 13N28 (South Creek Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 13N24 (Dry Lakes), then continues north and east along Forest Road No. 13N24 (Dry Lakes), to its intersection with Forest Road No. 17N12 (Soda Springs-Riverton Road), then continues north along Forest Road No. 17N12 (Soda Springs-Riverton Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 14N07 (Lawyer Cow Camp Road), then continues east along Forest Road No. 14N07 (Lawyer Cow Camp Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 14N27 (Bunker Meadow Road), then continues north and west along 14N27 (Bunker Meadow Road) to Little Mountain Meadow Creek, then continues west along Little Mountain Meadow Creek to Forest Trail No. 14E02 (Hellhole Trail), then continues north along Forest Trail No. 14E02 (Hellhole Trail) to the Eldorado National Forest boundary, then continues north and west along the Eldorado National Forest boundary to Forest Road No. 17N02 (Old Ice House Road), then continues southwest along Forest Road No. 17N02 (Old Ice House Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 14N08 (Eleven Pines Road), then continues SW along Forest Road No. 14N08 (Eleven Pines Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 14N25 (Blacksmith Flat Road), then continues SW along Forest No. 14N25 (Blacksmith Flat Road) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 13N65 (Ramsey Crossing), then continues south along Forest Road No. 13N65 (Ramsey Crossing) to Long Canyon, then continues west along Long Canyon to the Rubicon River, then continues south along the Rubicon River to Pilot Creek, then continues southwest along Pilot Creek to Wentworth Springs Road (ELD-63), then continues west along Wentworth Springs Road (ELD-63) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 12N64 (Sand Mountain Blvd), then

continues south along Forest Road No. 12N64 (Sand Mountain Blvd) to its terminus at Mosquito Road (ELD-60), then continues south along Mosquito Road (ELD-60) to the South Fork American River, then continues east along the South Fork American River to Federal Highway 50, then continues east along Federal Highway 50 back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map.
