

Recreation Residence Standards & Guidelines
Summary of changes between 2009 Version & 2014 Version

- Page 6: Added 2nd & 3rd paragraph to describe rationale for the update.
- Page 8: Under Procedures for Construction, Replacements, Additions, Modifications and New Improvements; Number 2: change to: ***“Requests must be made during the annual “Open Season” for new proposals, September 15-December 31 each year. Proposals to consider emergency situations will be accepted any time of year.*** (Open Season was implemented in 2011).
- Page 11: Number 2; Construction Section – more added emphasis on the ***historic values*** considerations.
- Page 17: Number 5; Seasonal Burning Permits – added that these are now obtained on-line at: www.burnpermits.idaho.gov.
- Page 22: Number 6: Change to recommended verbiage from Idaho Department of Lands on the use of open foam flotation billets not being allowed.
- Page 25: Number 4; who can be issued a recreation residence permit – change to “A recreation residence permit can only be issued to a single person, married couple, ***legal domestic partnership***, or a living family trust”.
- Page 26: Change the ***Sandpoint Ranger District contact information*** (address, phone) since they have moved.
- Page 26: Change to the new Idaho Panhandle National Forests website: www.fs.usda.gov/ipnf
- Page 36: Appendix C: Include the newly signed ***Programmatic Agreement between the Idaho Panhandle National Forests & the Idaho State Historic Preservation Office.***
