

TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER

CONDITIONS OF USE MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST

Under Authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, as amended, (16 U.S.C. 551) and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth at 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)). These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Code of Federal Regulations Title 36, Part 261, Subpart A, and become effective when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

PORTIONS OF THE MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST ON THE POPLAR BLUFF RANGER DISTRICT ARE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC ON MARCH 16TH THROUGH 17TH, 2015, FROM 8:00AM TO 5:00PM AS DESCRIBED BELOW, AND ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY (36 CFR 261.53 d & e and 36 CFR 261.54 a & e).

All NFS Lands within the legal description are temporarily closed to the public.


