Box Canyon Reoffer Timber Sale. Timber sale Contract 2400-6 will be used. The termination date for this sale is March 31, 2018.

Fifty percent or more of the timber in this sale is included timber that remained uncut upon termination of a previous contract with Intermountain Resources, LLC; P.O. Box 670 / 11925 6530 Road / Montrose, CO 81402. Title 36, Section 223.86 of the Code of Federal Regulations prohibits consideration of a bid for this sale from the previous purchaser or from any person currently affiliated with the previous purchaser. Bidders certify, by signing the bid form, that the bidder is not the purchaser or the third party who failed to complete the original contract and that the bidder is not an affiliate of this person.

There are 0.78 miles (1.26 kilometers) of specified road reconstruction, and 0.77 miles (1.24 kilometers) of specified road construction. A specified road construction cost of \$14,834.80 has been allowed in the appraisal for this work.

The minimum acceptable weighted average bid rate is \$8.03 per CCF.

There is a \$6,000.00 bid guarantee required on this sale.

Measurement of the estimated quantities will be made after felling. The total estimated quantity on this sale is 6,644 CCF.

Brooklyn Nash Timber Sale. Timber sale Contract 2400-6 will be used. The termination date for this sale is March 31, 2016.



The minimum acceptable weighted average bid rate is \$4.82 per CCF.

There is a \$700.00 bid guarantee required on this sale.


