**ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
RESTRICTING USE, TO WIT:
Rimrock and Overlooks
ALLEGHENY NATIONAL FOREST – PENNSYLVANIA**

Under the authority of the Act of Congress dated June 4, 1897, as amended (16 U.S.C. 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth as 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)), the following acts and omissions are prohibited until October 31, 2010, or until this order is rescinded, at the Rimrock Overlook located on the Bradford Ranger District, Allegheny National Forest, Warren County, Pennsylvania, said areas being described and designated as shown on the map set forth at Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereto:

- 1. All public entry and use of the area directly below the overlooks is prohibited for the protection of public safety. (36 CFR 261.53(e))**

THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TO PROTECT NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261. THE PROHIBITION WILL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THIS ORDER UNTIL SPECIFICALLY WITHDRAWN BY TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

Pursuant to the provisions of 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission (36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)); and,
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR 261.50(e)(4));

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 U.S.C., 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).

Public Notice


1. Copies of approved order and attachments shall be made available to the public at District Ranger Stations and the Office of the Forest Supervisor.
2. Contents of the order shall be posted on the Forest Web site.
3. Signs advising of restrictions shall be posted on informational bulletin board at Rimrock Overlook.
4. Signs shall be posted along trails leading into the closure area
5. Notice of closure shall be released the local newspaper and other media outlets

Enforcement

1. Patrols of the closure area shall be regularly conducted by Forest Protection Officers and by assigned Law Enforcement personnel.
2. Patrols shall verify that appropriate signing is in place.
3. All violations of the closure order shall be documented using appropriate law enforcement forms (Incident report (5300-1 or Violation Notice 5300-4)
4. Officers shall exercise appropriate discretion in the issuance of warnings and violation notices
5. Persistent and reoccurring violations shall be reported to the District Law Enforcement Officer


