**ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR  
RESTRICTING ALLEGHENY NATIONAL FOREST, TO WIT:**

**ALLEGHENY NATIONAL FOREST**

Under the authority of the Act of Congress dated June 4, 1897, as amended (16 USC 551) and the Secretary of Agriculture's regulation 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the Allegheny National Forest, located within Warren County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**For the protection of public safety it is prohibited to park or leave a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. (36 CFR 261.58 (g))**

THIS RESTRICTION IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY AS WELL AS FOREST SERVICE PROPERTY AND RESOURCES. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261. THE PROHIBITIONS WILL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THIS ORDER UNTIL SPECIFICALLY WITHDRAWN BY TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

*Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:*

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**Violation of the prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).**

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

1. Copies of the approved order and attachments shall be made available to the public at all District Ranger Stations as well as the office of the Forest Supervisor.
2. Contents of the order shall be posted on the forest website.

**ENFORCEMENT**

1. Enforcement of this closure order shall be limited to Law enforcement Officers and Special Agents. Forest Protection Officers observing a violation of this order shall notify LEOs or local authorities.
2. All violations of the closure order shall be documented using appropriate law enforcement forms.
3. Officers shall use appropriate discretion in the issuance of warnings and violation notices.

The purpose of this order is to provide for health and safety along Forest Roads.
