The Ironton Ranger District, of the Wayne National Forest is now accepting applications for the Youth Conservation Corps (YCC). The YCC crew will work on various projects to assist the recreation, timber, wildlife, and other natural resource programs. Projects may include trail constructions and maintenance, campground maintenance, wildlife surveys, and timber management.

The crew will consist of four members (2 male applicants, 2 female applicants). Crew members will work full-time for a period of 8 weeks (approximately June 01, 2015 – July 24, 2015). To be eligible for the program, participants must be 15 to 18 years of age during the YCC work period, approximately June 01- July 24, 2015. Participants must be available to work all 8 weeks.

Applications are due to the Ironton Unit Office in Pedro, OH, no later than 4:30 pm on Wednesday, April 15, 2015. Selection will be made from a random drawing held on April 17, 2015, and selected applicants will be notified. Selected applicants are REQUIRED to attend a meeting on Wednesday, April 28, 2015 at 6:00 pm, at the Ironton office to complete the hiring process (please bring state issued ID, Social Security card, Direct Deposit information).
