The TWO TOP OHV route mainly follows the same route as the snowmobile trail. This trail provides many scenic views and on a clear day, you can see 7 mountain ranges including the Tetons to the south. Watch for changing weather conditions, blown down trees on the trail and use extra caution when navigating through the several small rock gardens and areas of steeper inclines.

The SOUTH PLATEAU OHV route takes you 12 miles south of West Yellowstone mostly on forest service roads. There are several scenic vistas and in winter this area often receives 150" or more of snow.
