National Forest System Road and Trail Restriction

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on specified National Forest System roads and trails within the Pike National Forest in Colorado (the "Restricted Roads and Trails"). The Restricted Roads and Trails are shown on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A, and listed in Exhibit B.

This order is necessary to provide short-term resource protection.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Using any motor vehicle on the Restricted Roads, April 1 through May 31, annually. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54 (a)
2. Using any motor vehicle on the Restricted Trails, April 1 through May 31, annually. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55 (b)

EXEMPTIONS:


Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force, in the performance of an official duty.
3. Over- snow vehicles operating on at least 6" of snow.

This order supersedes, rescinds and replaces Order 10-06, dated March 31, 2010.

This order shall be in effect from April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2018, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual of \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571
