1/4 mile loop

Nugget Falls Trail: Moderate; gravel
2-mile round trip

Trail of Time: Moderate; paved &
gravel
1-mile loop

East Glacier Trail: Challenging; gravel,
rock & stairs
3-mile loop

Bear Safety

Black bears frequent this area, especially when salmon are in Steep Creek. Help keep bears wild and people safe:

- Stay on designated trails.
- No food or flavored beverages outdoors.
- Do not approach or run from bears. Give bears plenty of space.

- Smoke in designated area only.
- Walk bicycles on paved trails.
- Keep dogs on leash.



