Lookout Mountain Bike Trails

Mountain bikes provide a great way to explore the large expanses of the Superior National Forest. You can cover a lot of ground and still be close to nature. There are only a few areas specifically for mountain biking, but bicycles are welcome on the Forest road system, provided you use common sense and obey traffic regulations.

The Lookout Mountain Bike Trails feature 5 miles of dedicated mountain bike single track and over 6 miles of multi-use rideable ski trail. Keep the following things in mind:

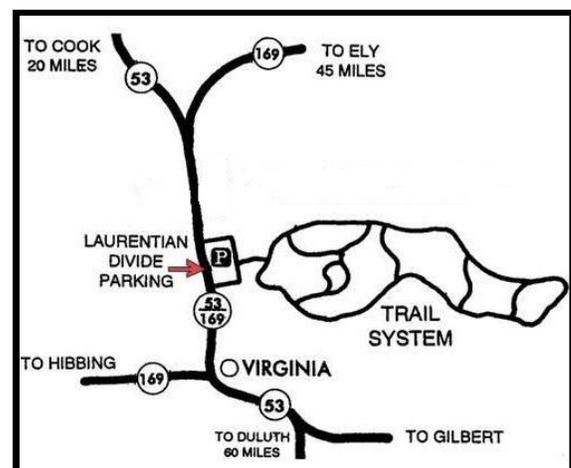
- Single file only; stay on the trail.
- Trails are two-way, so beware of oncoming bikes.
- Watch for hikers on the trails.
- Minimize erosion by not using the trails when they are wet.



The Lookout Mountain Bike Trails are developed in partnership with, and maintained by, the Iron Range off-Road Cyclists.

Location

From Virginia, take US Hwy 53/169 north for 4 miles. The trail system is located at the Laurentian Divide Recreation Area on the northbound lane. Parking is available in the lot.
