



**ORDER 18-2015-01-03**

**PUBLIC USE RESTRICTIONS**

**WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST  
MCKENZIE RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations §261.50(a), the following act(s) are prohibited on all lands administered by the Willamette National Forest on the McKenzie River Ranger District. These prohibitions will become effective upon signature, and will remain in effect until rescinded

**PROHIBITIONS:**

- (1) Entering or being upon an area which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. §36 CFR 261.53(e)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**DESCRIPTION OF AREA:** The Order applies to the area contained within the installed orange construction fence surrounding Cabin #4 in the Hoodoo Tract of Recreation Residences (approximately 2500 square feet). See attached map (Exhibit A)
