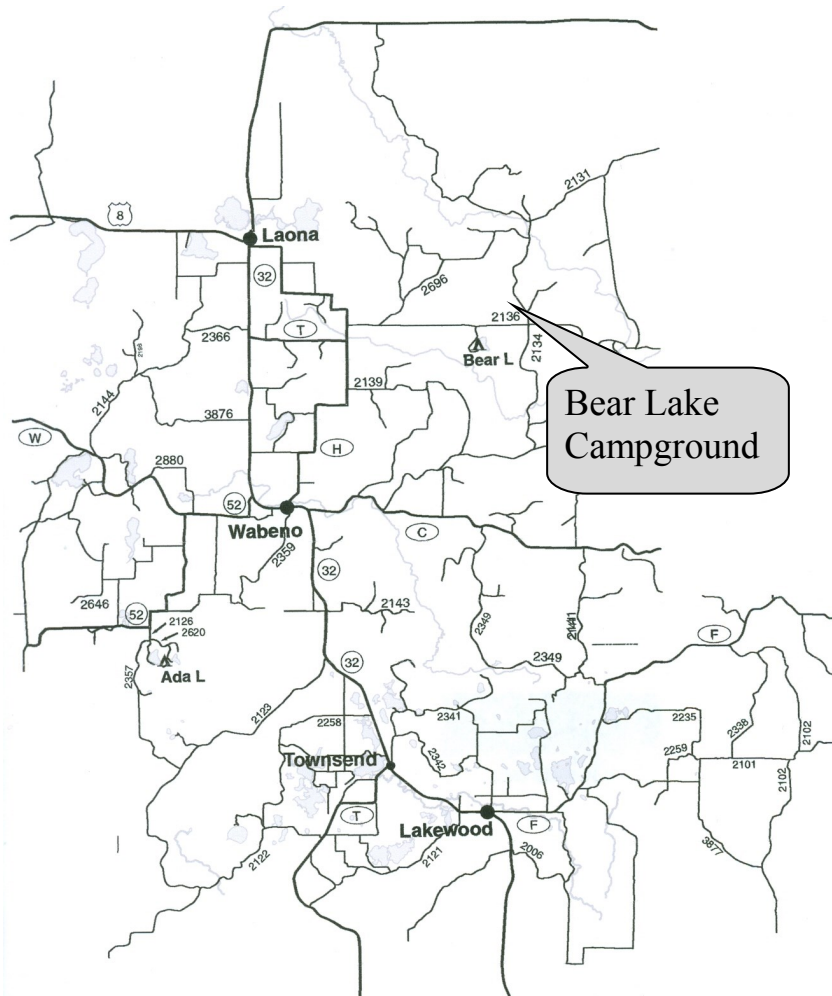

Directions to Bear Lake Campground

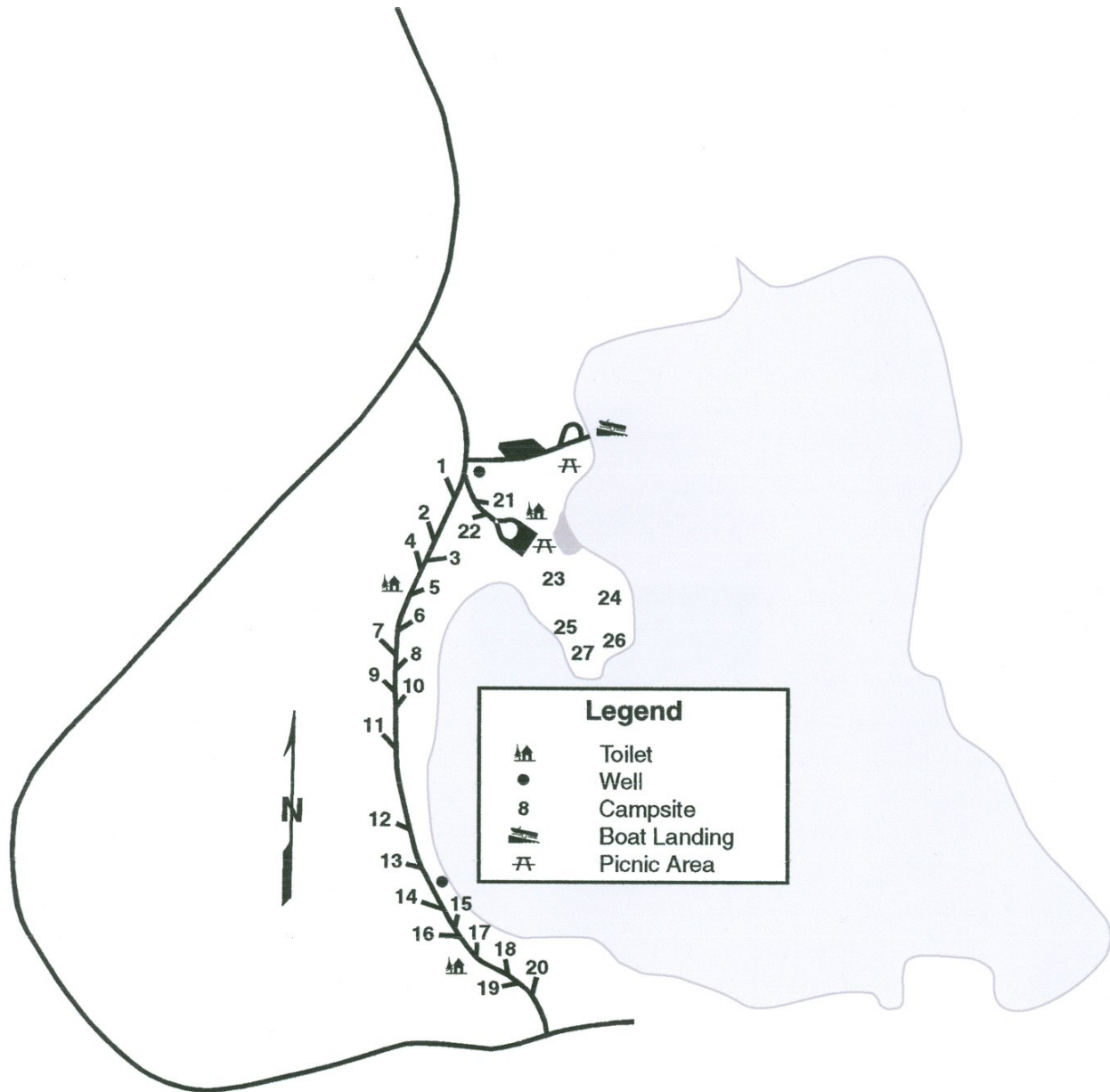
- From Wabeno, drive north 5.5 miles or from Laona drive south 3.0 miles to County Road T. Turn right (east) and drive 3 miles to County Road H. Turn left (north) drive 0.75 miles to Goodman Park Road (FR 2136). Turn east (right) and drive 4.1 miles to FR 3770. Turn right (south) on FR 3770 and drive 0.4 miles to the campground.



Bears!

Be bear aware while camping. Close and fasten campground waste containers. Lock food securely in vehicles, and never burn food waste.

Description

If you are interested in a quiet campground and excellent pike fishing, Bear Lake Camp-ground is for you. Campsites are situated along the wooded shore and ridge with outstanding views to the lake. Five walk-in sites are also available. The campground has a swim beach, picnic area and boat landing. Bear Lake is a 68 acre lake that also offers good fishing for largemouth bass, crappies, and other panfish. Motor use is restricted to electric motors only. The nearby Peshtigo and Rat Rivers offer good trout fishing. Nearby walking trails provide an excellent opportunity for fall grouse hunting.
