TRAIL CLOSURES ORDER

PROIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the "restricted roads and trails" described in this Order, and depicted on the attached maps hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, B, and C, all within the Silver City, Wilderness and Black Range Ranger Districts, Gila National Forest, Grant and Sierra Counties, New Mexico.

1. Being on the restricted roads. 36 CFR 261.54 (e)
2. Being on the restricted trails. 36 CFR 261.55 (a)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Residents, owners or lessees of land traveling on the restricted roads for the sole purpose of access to their private lands.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized fire fighting force in the performance of official duty.


**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is to provide for health and safety of the public in consideration of dangerous falling rocks, trees, flooding and debris fields on roads and trails created from the Silver fire of 2013 and Signal fire in 2014.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will go into effect on the date signed, and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until November 3, 2015, whichever occurs first.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581].
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
