*ROAD CLOSURE*  
*National Forest System Road #186A*  
*For Public Safety and Resource Protection*

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System Road described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will go into effect on April 12, 2015 at 11:59 P.M. and will remain in effect until further notice.

1. Using a motorized vehicle on the road (as described below). **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Planting contractors and their employees and agents.

**ROADS DESCRIPTION**

**National Forest System (NFS) Road 186A** (Upper Donnelly Road) is described as beginning at the intersection with NFS Road #186 and #186A located at Township 16 North, Range 2 East, Section 2 and traveling Northerly to the roads terminus located at Township 17 North, Range 2 East, Section 27

The above NFS Road is located within the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Valley County, ID.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this order is to provide for the protection of public health and safety and to prevent potential resource damage to the road during spring thaw conditions. Road #186A will be snowplowed to facilitate early season access for reforestation activities.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will go into effect on April 12, 2015 at 11:59 P.M. and will remain in effect until further notice.
2. Maps identifying the above-described road are attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.


**Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan  
Cascade Ranger District – Boise National Forest**

1. **Background.** Reforestation crews will be conducting reforestation work in an area accessed by NFS Road 186A (Upper Donnelly Road). The reforestation work must occur during the early spring season when moisture is still in the ground. To allow early season access, crews will remove snow and allow road surfaces to adequately dry. The road closure will start on April 12, 2015 and continue for approximately two weeks.
2. **Intent of Subpart B order.** This road closure is for all motorized traffic: to promote public safety, and prevent resource damage during the snow melting process.
3. **Enforcement Plan.** On the ground signing and maintenance of signs will occur along Forest System Road # 186A. Forest Staff and Law Enforcement will make compliance contacts as needed.


