## Volunteer Opportunities at Grey Towers

***Mansion and Garden Tours:*** Volunteers assist with interpretive tours of the mansion and adjacent garden areas.

***Seasonal and Special Events:*** Volunteers often pitch in to provide assistance during seasonal and special public events, such as the annual Festival of Wood or other events where we have large numbers of visitors.

***Gift Shop:*** Volunteer duties in our Interpretive Tower Shop include operating the cash register, stocking shelves, welcoming visitors and distributing educational products and materials.

***Conservation Education:*** Volunteers work with Forest Service staff to help deliver education programs to children at Grey Towers or at schools and camps.

***Conservation and the Arts:*** Volunteers assist our visitors at a variety of arts programs, including music, lectures, visual arts and literary programs.

***Conference Center Support:*** Volunteers assist at meetings, workshops, conferences, lectures and special public events held at the Grey Towers Conference Center.

***Landscape and Gardens:*** The Grey Towers Horticulture Team is made up of people who love to garden and can donate a few hours each week to improve and maintain the Grey Towers gardens.

***Trails:*** The volunteer Trail Team helps develop and maintain the trails at Grey Towers.

***Facility Maintenance & Protection:*** Volunteers assist with maintenance, including painting and other small repairs and small construction projects, and with special resource protection projects.

***History and Legacy:*** Volunteers assist our history and legacy projects by sorting and filing historic photos, conducting research projects and cataloging and inventorying artifacts.
