

2015 Spring Camping and Recreation Update

- The Mountain Home Ranger District plans to have all active campground water systems open by **May 15**.
- Fee collections and all services will be in place **May 15** at **Pine, Curlew, and Elks Flat Campgrounds**. Reservations start May 15 at Elks Flat Campground.
- **Dog Creek Campground remains closed to all entry** due to the 2013 Elk Complex fire impacts. Please reference the current fire closure for more details.
- There is a trail closure on the National Forest System Trail 045 (**Roaring River**) and National Forest System Trail 122 (**William Pogue**). Please reference that closure order for more details at <http://www.fs.usda.gov/boise>
- Repairs continue within the **Danskin Mountain Trail System**, hoping to have it open by early summer. The current closure order is still in place, please reference the closure for more detail. <http://www.fs.usda.gov/boise>
- Recreation sites still impacted from the debris event of September 2013: **Tailwaters Campground and Wilson Trailhead & Trail System**.
- Repairs have been completed in Evans Creek Campground and the Boat Ramp at Tailwaters Campground. At this time, these areas are still restricted to day use only. Please reference the Elk Complex fire closure.
- Anderson Ranch reservoir is looking good, there are concrete ramps available. Current reservoir water elevation is at 4172.39 ft. Elk Creek Ramp needs repaired, however the ramp is usable.
