


2015 Tusayan Ranger District Paid Personal Use Fuelwood Map Cutting Season: April 13th - December 31st, 2015

Standing Dead Cutting Limitations

The removal of standing dead trees is limited by species and size according to the following: Diameters are measured at 4 ½ feet above the ground.

- Ponderosa Pine – Only dead, standing trees less than 12 inches in diameter (38 inches in circumference) or less than 15 feet in height may be removed.
- Pinyon Pine – Only dead, standing trees less than 10 inches in diameter (32 inches in circumference) or less than 12 feet in height may be removed.
- Juniper – Only dead, standing trees less than 20 inches in diameter (63 inches in circumference) or less than 12 feet in height may be removed.
- Gambel Oak – Only dead, standing trees less than 8 inches in diameter (25 inches in circumference) or less than 12 feet in height may be removed.

Standing dead oak may only be removed between June 1 and October 15.
Dead Limbs cannot be cut from live trees.
