




Show off your best wildflower photos at the annual Siskiyou County Mother's Day Wildflower Show!

Wildflower photographs can be in color or black & white, close-up or landscape, with or without pollinators.

Photographs must be 8 x 10 in size and be mounted on a matte board.

Flowers should be reflected in their native habitat or in natural settings. Potted, garden, or greenhouse flowers will not be accepted.
