



# White Azalea Campground

## Eldorado National Forest Amador Ranger District

### Location

38 miles east of Jackson on Highway 88, 8.5 miles south on Forest Road 92 (Ellis Road), and 3 miles east on Forest Road 8N50 (Salt Springs Road).

### Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming
- ⇒ Fishing
- ⇒ Picnicking
- ⇒ Car top boat launching available at Salt Springs Reservoir. Access to the water is difficult. Boating is hazardous when windy (usually in the afternoons).
- ⇒ Hiking in Mokelumne Wilderness (permit required for overnight use, year round). Permits available at Carson Pass Information Station (summer only) and the Amador Ranger Station. The trailhead is at Salt Springs Reservoir.


### Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ Restroom cleaning is provided mid-May to mid-November. No garbage service. Pack it In, Pack it Out.
- ◆ There is no piped water at the campground. Water from the river is available but should be boiled before using. Water quality testing is not performed on open water sources.
- ◆ Vehicles with an Off-Highway Vehicle license “green or red sticker” are not legal on campground roads.
- ◆ OHV’s must be trailered to staging areas and authorized routes in the Bear River Reservoir area.
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood.
- ◆ Check ahead. Campfires may not be allowed during fire restrictions.
