On 05/04/2015, at 10:00 AM, sealed bids will be opened in the Yreka, California for the Little Deer Fire Salv MP SBA sale. This sale is located in T44N, R2W, sec. 3-10, 16-19; T44N, R3W, sec. 1, 12, 13, 24; MDM; Siskiyou County. Timber sale Contract 2400-6 will be used. The termination date for this sale is 10/31/2016. This is a small business set-aside sale.

This sale will be preferentially awarded to a qualified small business concern. In the absence of any bids from a self-certifying qualified small business concern, the sale will be readvertised without restriction on the size of bidders.

Measurement of the estimated quantities will be made after felling. The total estimated quantity on this sale is 40,192 Ton.
