Description:

The map displays a potential recommended wilderness area that would be an addition to the existing Monarch Wilderness.

The potential recommended wilderness is an Inventoried Roadless Area located at the southern end of the Sierra National Forest adjacent to the Sequoia National Forest. The north, west, and east boundaries of the area are identical to the boundaries of the Sierra NF portion of the existing Kings River Special Management Area. The southern boundary excludes road 12S01 along the Kings River and road 12S01A. East of the end of road 12S01, the boundary follows the Kings Wild and Scenic River. The area is bordered on the east by the Monarch Wilderness.
