## **Allegheny National Forest District Offices to begin summer hours; ATV trails to reopen May 22, 2015**

**Warren, Pa.** (May 8, 2015) – The Allegheny National Forest’s Bradford and Marienville Ranger Districts will begin summer hours.

- The **Marienville Ranger District**, located at 131 Smokey Lane; Marienville, PA will be open seven days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. starting **May 16, 2015**.
- The **Bradford Ranger District**, located at 29 Forest Service Dr.; Bradford, PA will be open Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. starting **May 23, 2015**.

In addition, all the forest ATV trails open on Friday, May 22, 2015. Riding the ATV trails requires a permit, which can be purchased at any of the Allegheny National Forest offices or any authorized vendors. The list of vendors can be found on the Allegheny’s website. The 2015 ATV and trail bike permits cost \$10 for a day permit or \$35 for an annual permit.
