## ***Emigrant Creek Ranger District fee campgrounds scheduled to be temporarily closed for hazard tree removal***

**JOHN DAY, OR** – Fee campgrounds on the Emigrant Creek Ranger District will be closed temporarily between May 11-15 as crews work to remove hazard trees from various sites.

Crews will work through the campgrounds in the following order. Once all flagged hazard trees are removed, the campgrounds will open back up for public use.
