EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-08-15-02 ROAD CLOSURES

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and 261.53(e) and 261.54(e) because certain National Forest System Roads are not safe for traffic due to recent flooding, I am closing the following:

AREA CLOSED: NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD (NFSR) 904, NFSR 900A, and portions of NFSR 900 located in Wise County, Texas.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Closure Order is effective May 22, 2015 and continues until May 29, 2015 or until rescinded.

PROHIBITED ACTS: No vehicle may enter, go into or be upon NFSR 904, NFSR 900A, and portions of NFSR 900 as shown closed on the attached map.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with permission from a forest officer;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- (3) Emergency crews who are repairing roads or restoring utility services; and
- (4) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
