

Protect all National Forest Property Boundary markers, stakes, and signs along private land, B6.23.

Cutting Unit boundaries are identified as "Bailey Salvage" on blue tags accompanied by orange paint. Roadside units boundaries are posted at the beginning and end of harvest segments, B1.1, C2.35.

Landlines shown on Sale Area Map are approximate.

All sale roads are restricted, C5.12#.

Roads to be kept open, applies to all roads listed in C5.31#, except roads 2730-550, 2630-013, 2600-600 and 450-630 which will be "for logging use only" and kept closed to the public.

Purchaser and Forest Service will agree on procedures for Purchaser use of roads behind gates, B5.12

Scarification and seeding of landings and temporary roads required, C6.6#.

Stump Heights: Stump heights shall be 8 inches or less within 75 feet of Highway 26 and FS RD 2630 unless hidden by topographic features, A6.

Slash Treatment Requirements apply to all areas resulting from purchaser's operations, C6.74.

All trail markers whose shape and color have been designated by the Forest Service as official trail markers shall be protected and replaced if damaged, B6.22.
